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## SARTECH II Testing, May 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> 2006

If any Team member wishes to attempt the SARTECH II or III certification test, be sure to let one of the officers know. You do not need to take ISAR, FUNSAR or ADSAR to attempt any of the certification tests, but it sure does help. We am not sure of cost just yet, but I think it is around \$35 - \$50. Any Team member who wishes to take the test may do so, but will have to pay the cost up front for each test. If you pass the test, the Team has agreed to reimburse your testing fee. If you have taken and passed the FUNSAR course in the past year, you do not need to take the written portion.

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## Information to Report to Planners after a Search

1. Estimated forward search speed of the individual or team while searching.
2. How long the individual or team searched (excluding rest breaks and such).
3. Field measurements of average maximum detection range (AMDR).
4. Other field-observable measures identified and requested by search planners prior to the assignment.
5. A qualitative description of how well the team did with the search.
6. A qualitative description of the search conditions.
