## Search Missions

We were asked to participate in a recovery search in the U.P. near Republic on September 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>. We assisted in Command along with Headwaters SAR & People & Paws SAR. The victim has since been found and for our efforts, the family has sent us a check for \$200.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> of October, we were contacted to assist with a recovery search near Pembine. We responded along with Headwaters SAR and after two hours of searching, one of the dog teams located the victim. We provided the overhead and also communications for the search.

Andy had the opportunity to travel to Minnesota to assist with a search for a missing hiker near the Boundary Waters north of Finland, MN. By all evidence of the search, it appears that it was a suicide or possible survival expedition for a missing 21 year old college student.

## Training

If you have been falling behind on your training requirements, contact Andy or Tim and we will work on getting you up to speed. Also, the Team does have some very good resources for you to use or study. If they are not in the trailer, contact Andy.

I know it's hard folks to get together with everything else going on, but remember, it's the 2 year old out in the cold hiding from us or the 78 year old hunter lost in the cold rain, that we formed our Team.
