#### **Fund Raisers**

We will participating in two fund raisers in May, 2004. Please plan to have days and Saturday's available the first three weeks of May.

- 1. <u>Nicolet Run/walk</u> We participated in this last year, with an addition of close to \$450 to our account. We will be participating again this year and we need Team members specifically representing us. Plan to be at Maiden lake Supper Club at 7:00am on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2004.
- 2. <u>Super Valu</u> Terry Rank has asked us to participate in a fund raiser the first three weeks of May, 2004. ### **Other Updates**

- 1. We added a radio system, including a programable VHF radio, FRS UHF radio and a CB radio with antennas, all self contained.
- 2. We have completed and sent in our request for Federal Tax Exemption, the 501(c) number.
- 3. We are looking at getting a generator to be self sufficient and looking for a heavy duty 100 foot extension cord. Anyone have one?
